INDIVIDUALS AGE 16 -17 (Minors):

- 1. Possess a valid DE964 certificate showing completion of the teen Driver's Education program.
- 2. Must Bring VOE form from your High School
- 3. Have a valid learner's license for a minimum of 6 months.
- 4. View the ITTD video and receive a certificate dated within 90 days of taking the road test. This must be signed by the parent and student. The website to watch the free state-required video is https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov Choose the Teen Drivers video.

INDIVIDUALS 18 TO 24 YEARS OF AGE:

- 1. Possess a valid DE964 or ADE1317 certificate showing completion of a
- 2. Teen or Adult Driver's Education program.
- 3. Have a valid learner's license.
- 4. If you did a driver's ed program as a teen, you must watch the ITTD video. See step 4 above. If you did the 6 hours Adult Driver's Ed program, see the next step.
- 5. View the ITYD video and receive a certificate dated within 90 days of taking the road test. This must be signed by the individual. The website to watch the free state-required video is https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov Choose the Young Drivers video.

INDIVIDUALS 25 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER:

- 1. Possess a valid learners license.
- 2. View the ITYD video and receive a certificate dated within 90 days of taking the road test. This must be signed by the individual. The website to watch the free state-required video is https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov Choose the Young Drivers video.
